



IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

MAINTENANCE & CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHROME AND BLACK PLASMA™ PARTS

Congratulations, you have purchased a superior product from America's premier Automotive Aftermarket Manufacturer - Edelbrock. With the proper care and cleaning, your Chrome Plasma or Black Plasma manifold and carburetor will continue to look good and keep their high gloss shine for years. Both finishes have a protective clear powder-coat top-coat, which is durable but must be cared for properly.

CLEANING YOUR CARBURETOR OR MANIFOLD:

NEVER clean your Plasma coated parts with strong solvents or carburetor cleaners of any kind. Use of these cleaners will dull the luster and possibly remove the coating. Do not use paper towels to wipe Plasma parts. Paper towels leave fine scratches. Use a micro-fiber towel instead. Although we test our coated products with various fuel types, some gasoline formulations may stain the clear powder coat top surface. Make sure you eliminate all fuel leaks and take extra care to wipe off any gasoline that comes in contact with your coated parts from normal maintenance activities.

ALWAYS clean your Plasma coated parts with mild soap and water or non-solvent cleaners such as Simple Green. Use of products such as Novus No. 1 or Eastwood Plastic Clean & Shine or other products listed below will help keep the shine and act as a dust repellent. When cleaning always use a clean, soft cotton, non-abrasive, absorbent, lint-free, micro-fiber cloth and a gentle cleaning motion.

SCRATCH REMOVAL:

DO NOT use a chrome polish or a scratch remover that is not clear coat safe. For best results, a high-quality polish such as Novus No.2 Fine Scratch Remover, Meguiars or Mothers Plastic Polish should be used. Before the application of any scratch removal product ensure the surface of the part is clean and free of any dirt or grime and follow the directions of the cleaning product carefully. Test a small area first.

NOTE: Any cleaning products used on your Plasma parts **MUST** be clear coat safe or developed for the cleaning of acrylic coatings. We suggest applying any automotive wax coat after cleaning, this will help to seal the surface and protect the finish. **Use of abrasive or solvent cleaners will void your manufacturer's warranty.**
