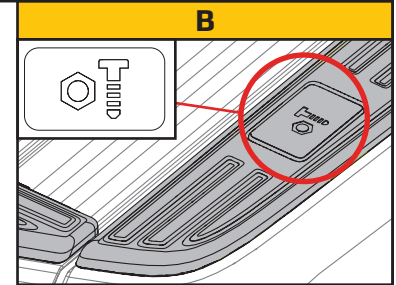
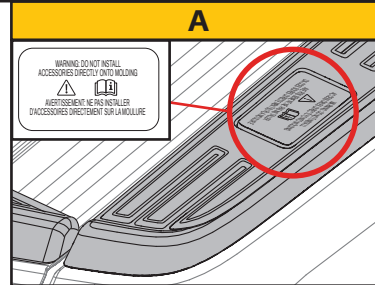
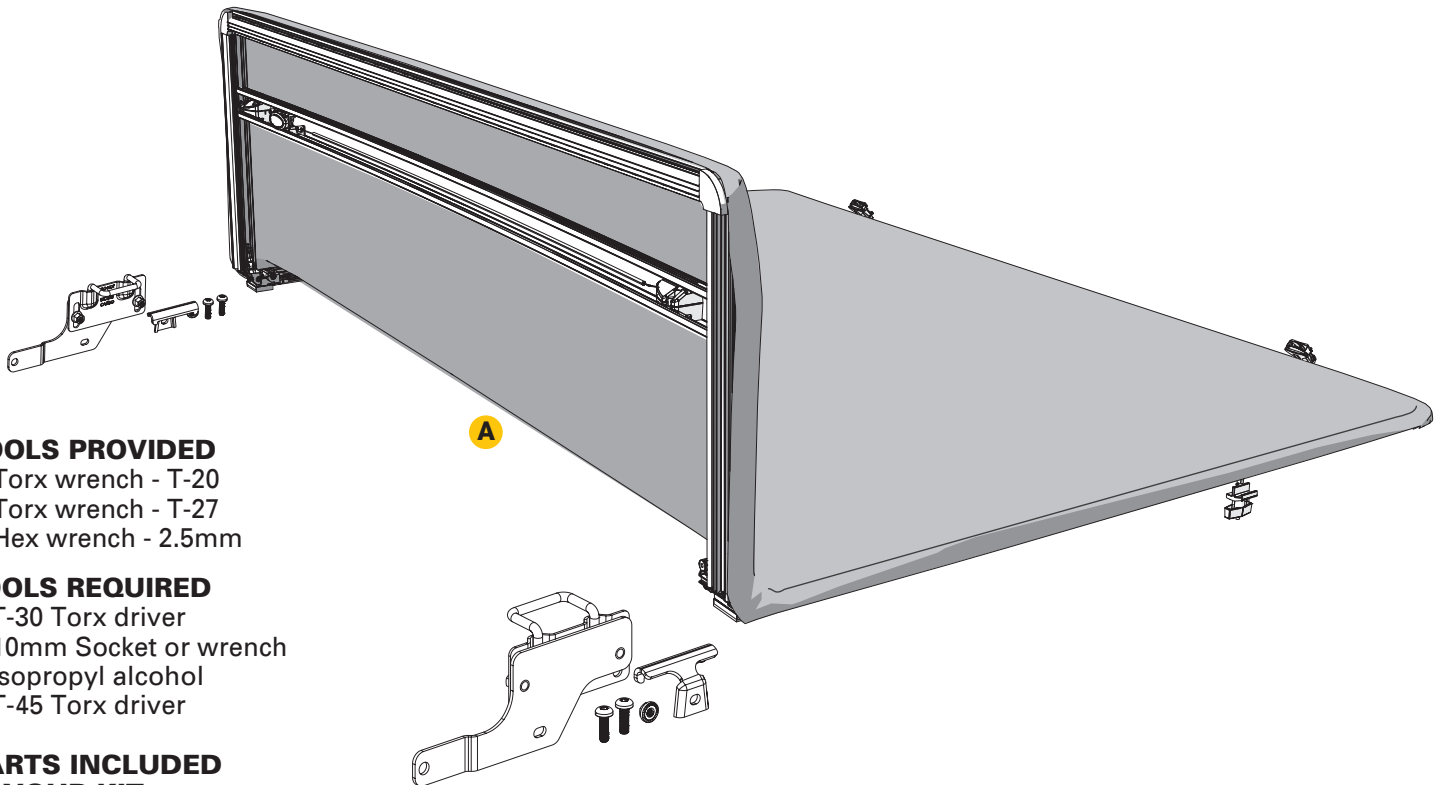


Prior to installation, it is important to examine the bed rails of your vehicle to accurately determine which model year you have. For our purposes, if your bed rail stake pocket covers look like picture A, we refer to your truck as the 2024 model year. If they look like picture B, we refer to your truck as the 2025 model year.



NOTE: It is important that all the areas where the bed cover mounts to the truck are clean and free of debris before installation.

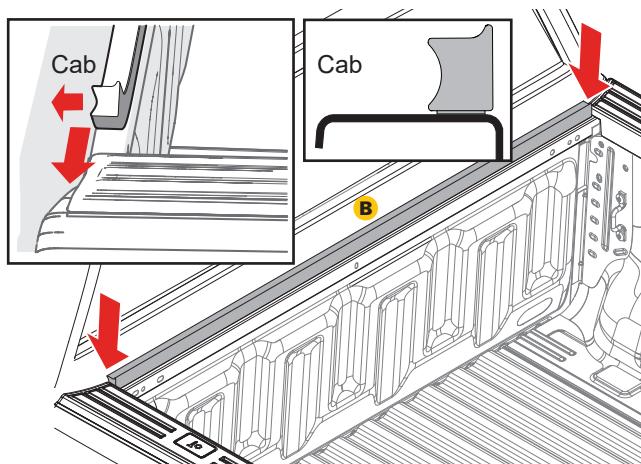
Note: Components D-I are the same in this kit along with the two listed below.

- J** 1x Bulkhead seal
- K** 2x Cab brackets

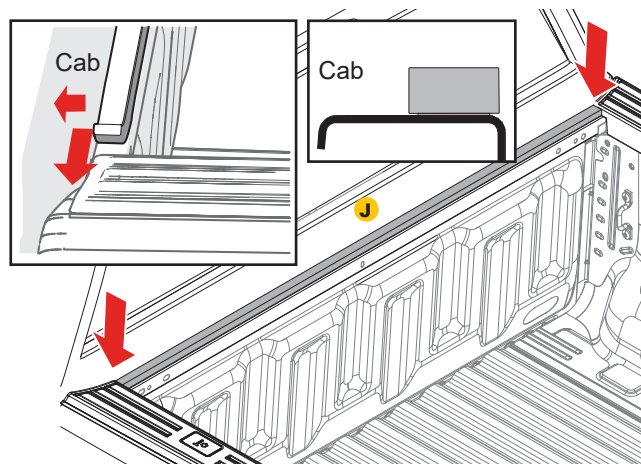


- 1** Install the bulkhead seal. Clean the top of the bulkhead where the seal will go with soap and water to remove dirt and debris. Then clean the same area with isopropyl alcohol to remove wax or grease and to evaporate any remaining water. Allow the surface to dry. The seal should be placed flush with the front edge of the bulkhead and should be snug between the truck bed rails. Peel the backing paper from the bulkhead seal (B) for **2024 models** and bulkhead seal (J) for **2025 models** and apply pressure to the entire seal to make sure that the adhesion is good.

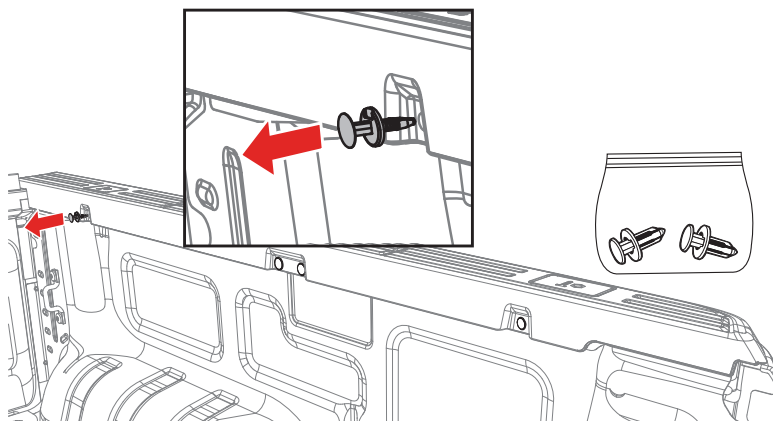

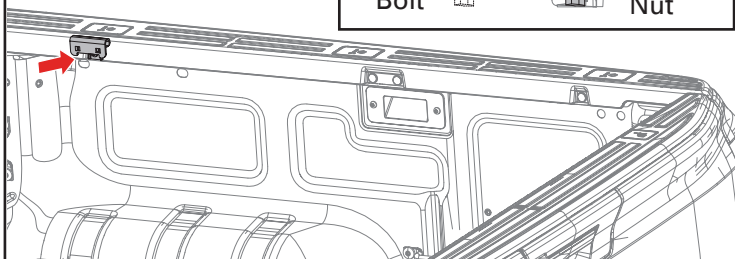
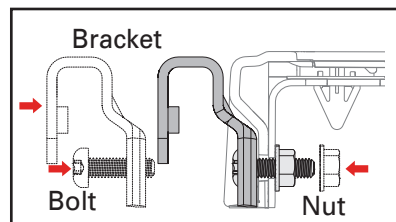
- 2** Remove the two corner plastic clips from the passenger and driver side bed caps as shown below. Pry out the center first, then pry out the entire clip. These will not be used again unless you permanently remove the bed cover assembly. Store clips in a plastic bag and put them in your glove box of vehicle.



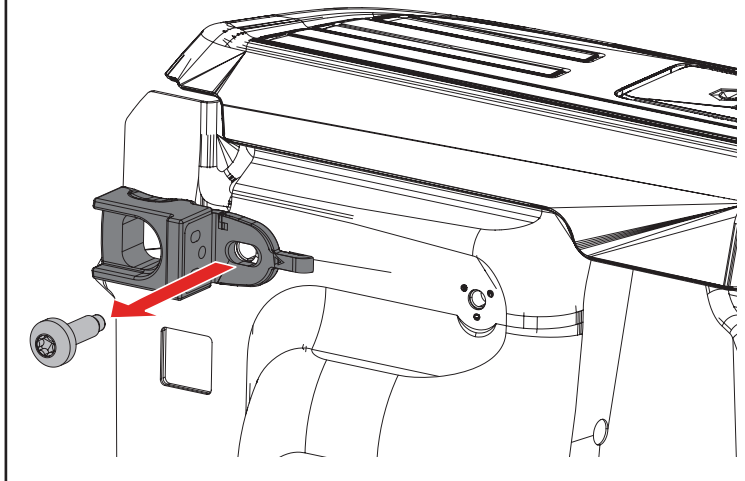
- 3a** **FOR 2024:** Install the brackets (C), bolts (D) and nuts (E) provided using the T-30 tool on the passenger and driver side bed caps, where you removed the two corner clips in Step 1. Make sure the nut is behind the sheet metal, as shown below.
NOTE: Torque to 8 ft/lbs (11 Nm).



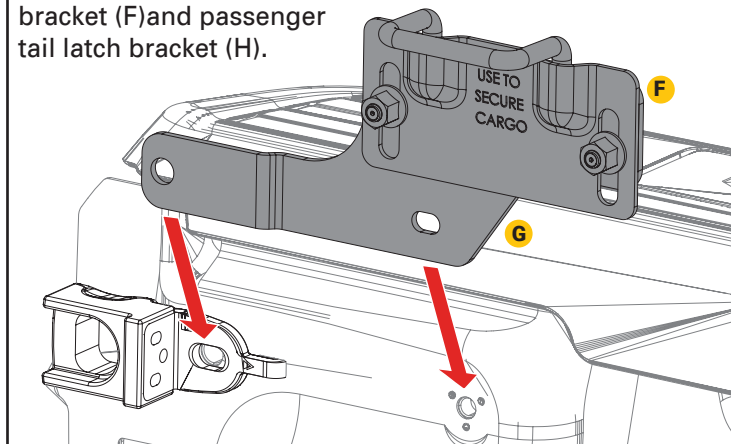
- 3b** **FOR 2025:** Install the brackets (K), bolts (D) and nuts (E) provided using the T-30 tool on the passenger and driver side bed caps, where you removed the two corner clips in Step 1. Make sure the nut is behind the sheet metal, as shown below.
NOTE: Torque to 8 ft/lbs (11 Nm).



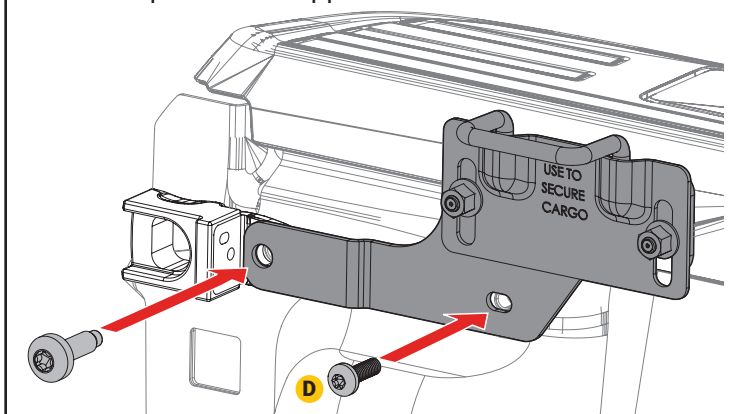
- 4** Remove the T-45 Torx screw from the tailgate slam bumper. **Do not discard screw.** Repeat on the opposite side of the truck bed.



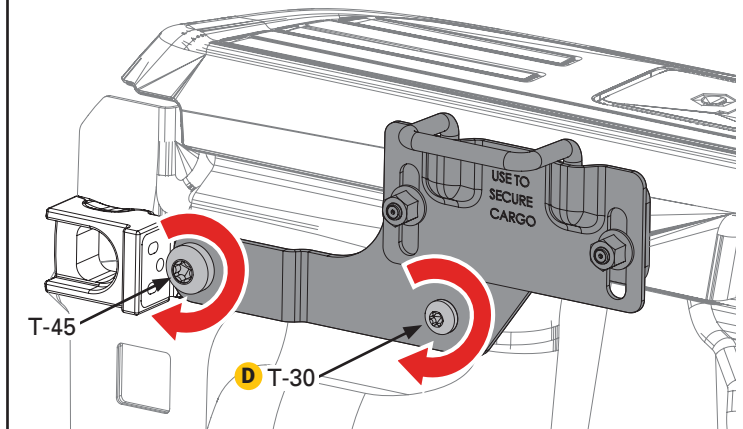
- 5** The brackets are assemblies comprised of the striker bracket (F) and a driver tail latch bracket (G). Align the two holes in the driver tail latch bracket (G) with the tailgate slam bumper hole you removed the Torx screw from in step 8 and the other hole in the side of the bed as shown. Repeat on the opposite side of the truck bed with striker bracket (F) and passenger tail latch bracket (H).



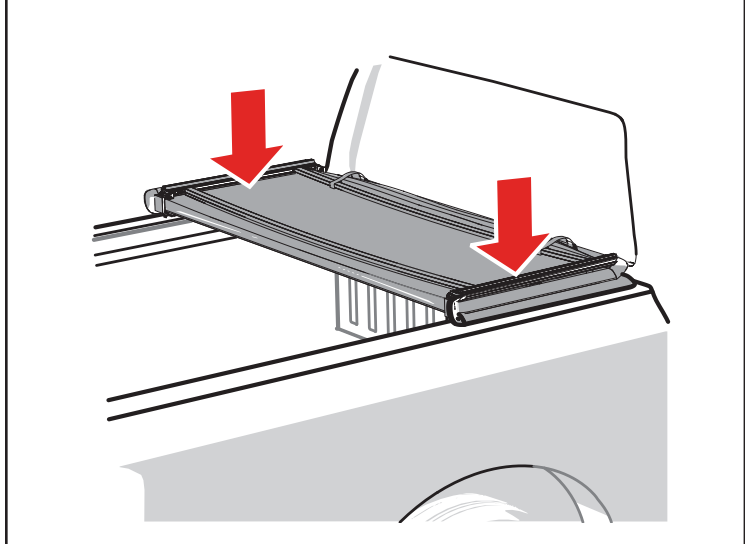
- 6** Re-install one of the T-45 Torx screws from step 8 through the bracket (G) and into the same hole you removed it from. Then install one of the provided T-30 Torx bolts (D) into the other hole in the same bracket and into the hole in the side of the bed. Loosely fasten the screws. Repeat on the opposite side of the truck bed.



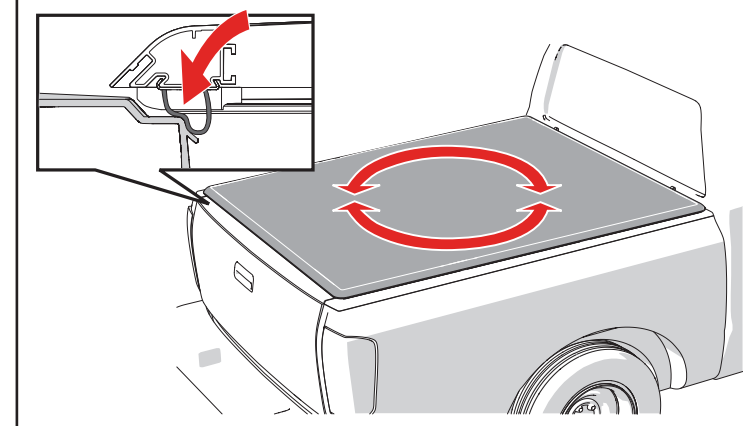
- 7** Tighten the Torx screw removed in step 4 using a T-45 Torx bit and torque to 16ft-lbs (22Nm) & using a T-30 Torx bit and torque bolt (D) to 8ft-lbs (11Nm). Repeat on the opposite side of the truck bed.



- 8** Place the folded, assembled bed cover (A) over the cab end of the truck box.

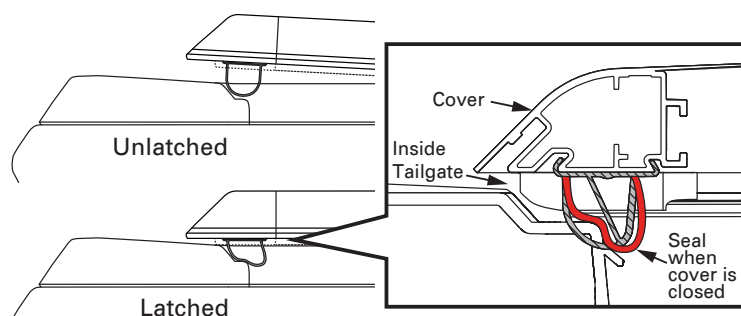


- 9** Unfold the bed cover (A) fully and adjust position over the truck bed for proper front (cab) and rear (tailgate) alignment. When positioned front and back, the tailgate seal should contact the tailgate as shown in step 10.

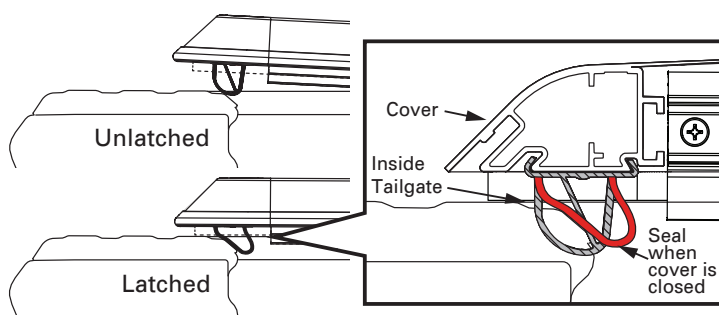


10 PROPER POSITION OF TONNEAU COVER. Close the tailgate and unfold the cover. Check that the cover is parallel and square with the truck bed and bed rails. Adjust the cover until the bulb seal fits with the tailgate as shown. If not parallel or square, open the cover and loosen the cab clamps to reposition the cover. If the cover is too far back the tailgate will not close.

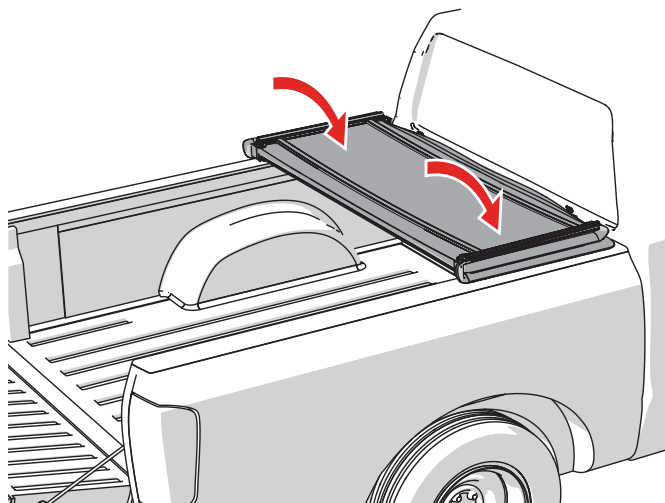

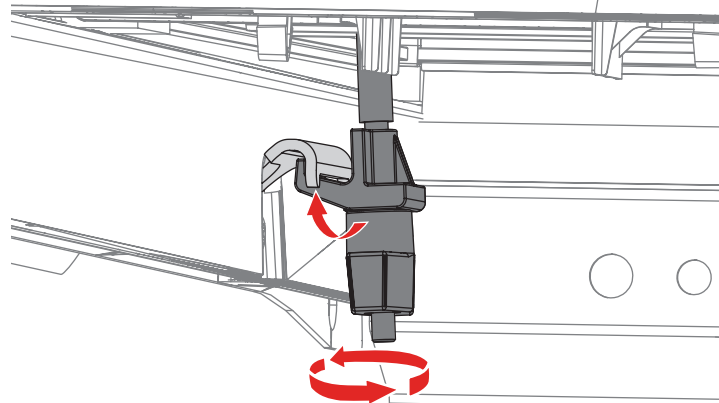

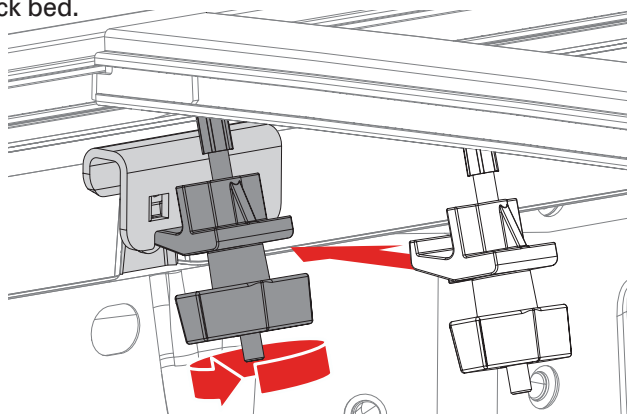
11 Carefully refold the bed cover (A) without shifting its position on the truck bed.



12a FOR 2024: Hook the cab clamp under the installed cab rail brackets (C). **NOTICE:** Do not secure to the plastic bed rail or bed cap. The clamp must contact the metal bracket. Ensure that the clamp is positioned under the metal bracket and hand tighten until the jaw makes contact, then tighten an additional two turns. **NOTICE: DO NOT** use a wrench or over tighten. Repeat on the opposite side of the truck bed.

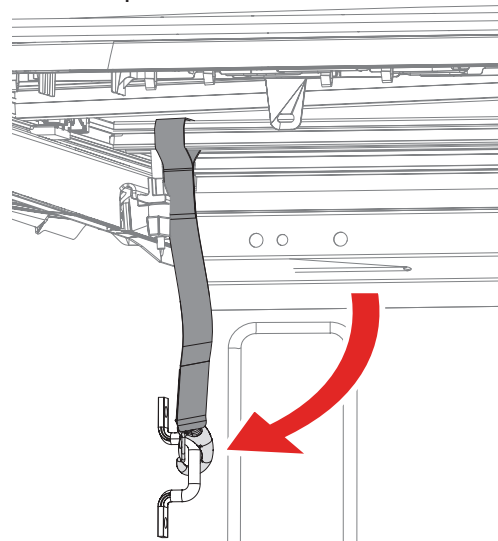


12b FOR 2025: Hook the cab clamp under the installed cab rail brackets (K). **NOTICE:** Do not secure to the plastic bed rail or bed cap. The clamp must contact the metal bracket. Ensure that the clamp is positioned under the metal bracket and hand tighten until the jaw makes contact, then tighten an additional two turns. **NOTICE: DO NOT** use a wrench or over tighten. Repeat on the opposite side of the truck bed.

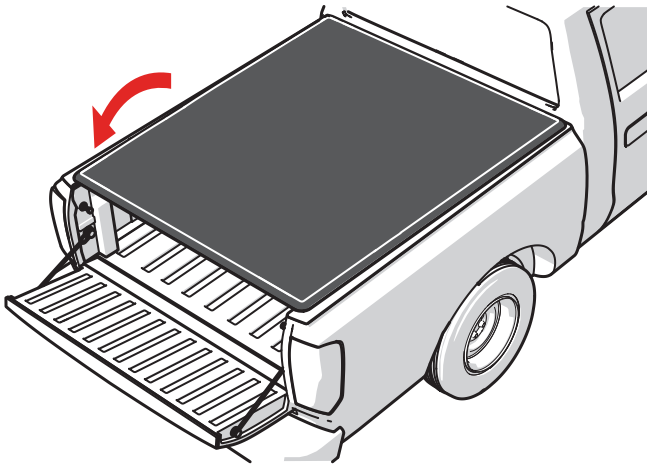


13 The tethers come installed looped over the bed cover bow with a clamp at the other end.

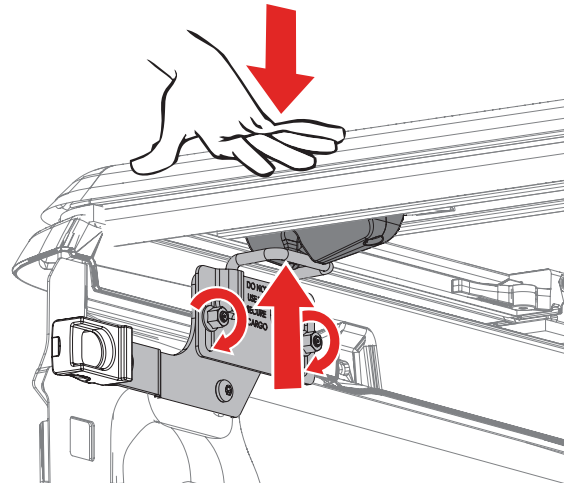
Attach the hook/tether to the front tie-downs on both the driver and passenger side.



- 14** With the tailgate open and the front (cab) clamps secure, completely close the bed cover.



- 15** Align the latch with the striker bracket (F). Push down on the cover while tightening the lock nuts (I) with 10mm socket or wrench.



- 16** Adjustments and tightening of the latch assembly is required.

The bed cover latch assemblies and rotary knob come from the factory only partially tightened to allow for installation adjustments. Both latches and rotary knob will require adjustment and final tightening. **Only use the hand tools provided, do not use power tools.**

Lower the rear of the bed cover and adjust the position of each latch so that they engage with the striker brackets, (Fig. 1). With the latches adjusted, from underneath the cover, use the provided T-20 Torx wrench to tighten the two screws, (Fig. 2) in both the driver and passenger side latches.

The cable from the driver's side latch comes routed through the barrel clamp of the actuator and hangs out. Slide the actuator so that 3/4" - 1" (19.1 - 25.4mm) of cable extends through the barrel clamp, (Fig. 3).

Rotate the actuator knob until you see the flat head screws. Tighten the two flat head screws using the provided T20 hex wrench, (Fig. 3).

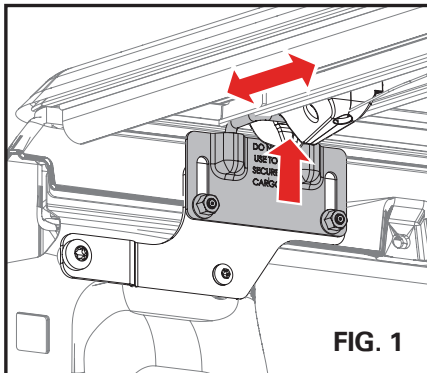

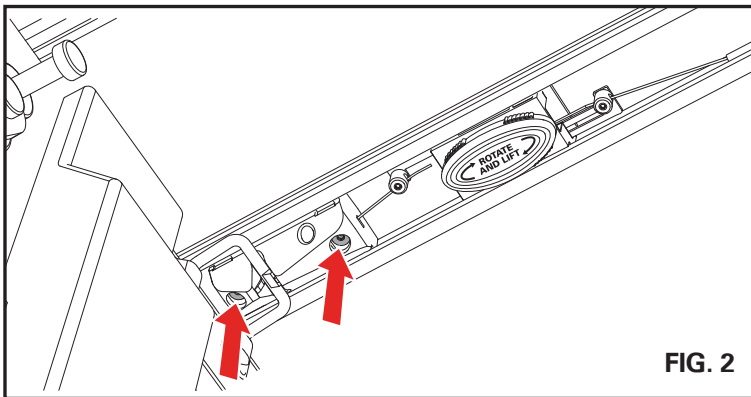

The cable from the passenger side latch comes routed through the other barrel clamp of the actuator. Excess cable length is routed through the middle of the actuator assembly (above the bottom plate below the plastic housing). Do not trim the excess cable, leave it for future adjustments, (Fig. 3).

Next, tighten the barrel clamps, (Fig. 4) with the provided 2.5mm hex key to secure the latch cables. Rotate the actuator knob, (Fig. 4) to verify that the latches disengage from the striker brackets.

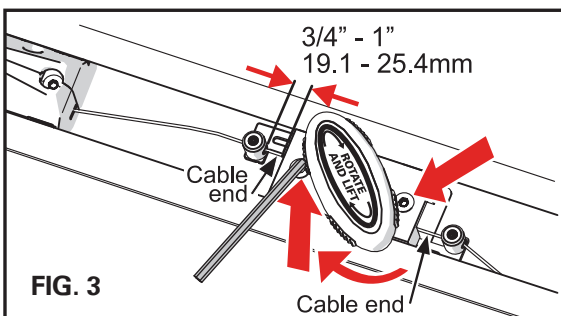

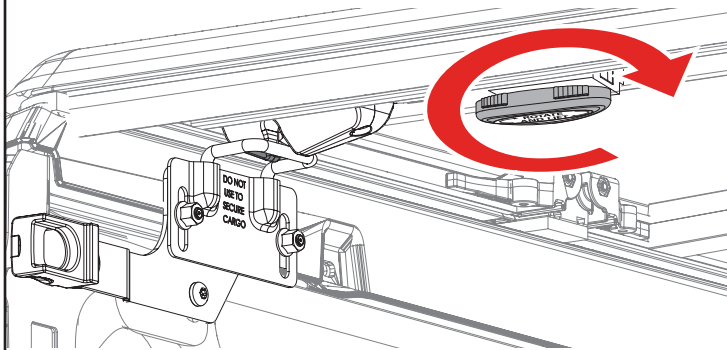
Double-check that the cover is secure and tight to the truck bed by gently lifting the corners to ensure the mechanisms are engaged.

- 17** To make the final adjustment, loosen the striker bracket nuts. Then move the striker bracket (F) down by firmly pushing the cover (A) or pulling the rear bow downward to the truck rail and tailgate. Make sure that both sides match, then retighten the screws.



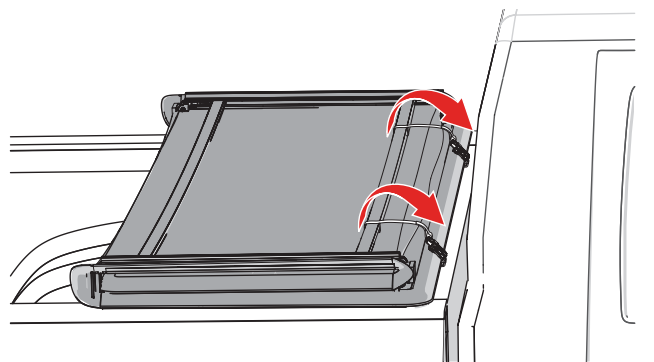
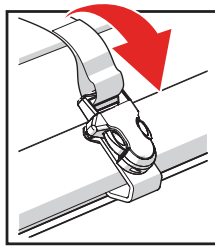
Opening the cover

Open the cover by twisting the actuator knob and lifting the cover.



Securing the cover

To drive with the cover open, fold the cover forward to the cab and fasten BOTH straps in the middle section to the front rail. Check that the straps are tight, and pull the strap end if too loose.



IMPORTANT

Re-tighten the front/cab clamps and tethers after the first week of driving the vehicle. Also periodically check the clamps and tethers to ensure they are secure.

Closed/Extended Position – Bed cover must be completely secured by all four (4) clamps.

Open/Folded Position – Bed cover must be completely folded up (all panels) and secured at the cab with the provided buckles straps and with both tethers attached.

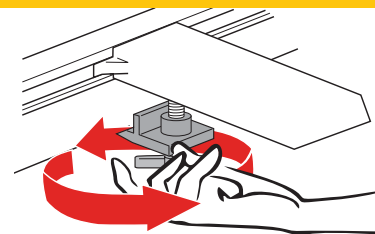
Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position.



Do NOT allow the vehicle to be towed backwards without first removing the cover from the vehicle.

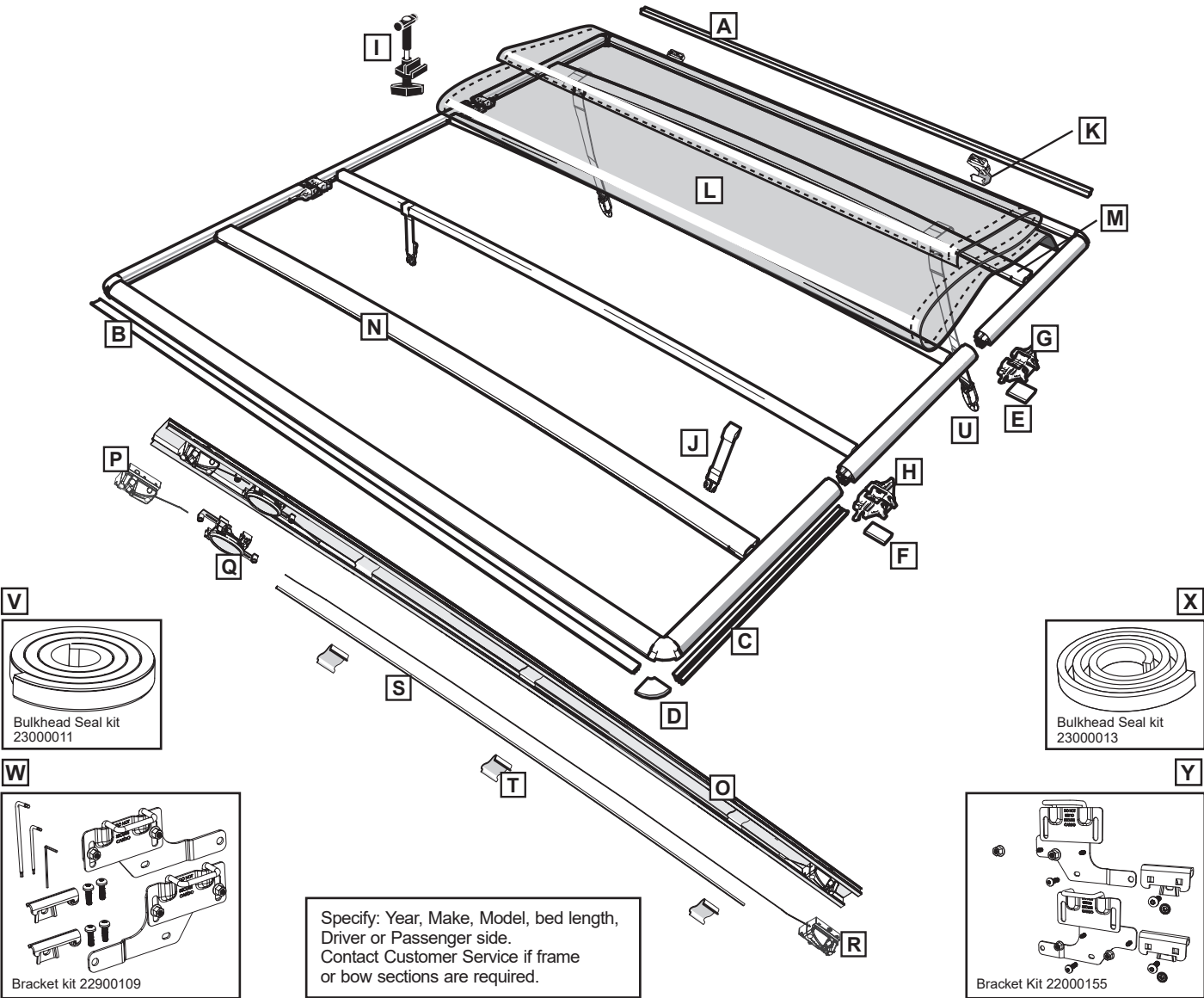


Remove any snow or foreign matter before folding the bed cover.

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

The cover, including as applicable any hardware kit (e.g., rails, clamps, and bows) and fabric, carries a limited lifetime warranty. This limited warranty is subject to the following terms:

WARRANTY COVERAGE

This tonneau cover is warranted against defects in materials or workmanship. This warranty is void if the product has been damaged in an accident, or due to neglect, unforeseeable use, improper installation, improper servicing, or other cause not arising out of defects in material or workmanship.

WARRANTY IS NOT TRANSFERABLE

The warranty is to the initial owner purchasing the tonneau cover and it is not transferrable to a subsequent end user. Proof of purchase may be required to enforce the warranty rights.

WARRANTY CONDITIONS

Failure to follow these warnings and care instructions will void the warranty:

- Clean with mild automotive soap and water only.
- Do not use conditioners that contain silicone or petroleum.
- Tonneau cover must be secured at all points when vehicle is in motion. When not fully extended, cover must be completely folded up and secured at the cab with the provided buckle straps and tethers attached. Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position..
- Check front/cab clamps and retention mechanisms for tightness after a week of driving following installation (or re-installation) of the cover and periodically thereafter.
- Before opening, cover must be free of all foreign materials including snow and ice.
- To avoid potential damage to the cover, panel clamps/latches must be in their stored positions prior to opening/folding the panel.
- Do NOT tow your vehicle from the rear with the cover on your vehicle. If towing from the rear is required, the cover MUST be removed from the vehicle and properly stored.

WARRANTY PERFORMANCE

If all warranty conditions are met, a defective tonneau cover, tarp, or hardware component will either be repaired or replaced (at our option). We reserve the right, for any warranted return, to substitute a newer model of tonneau cover having similar form and function, to offer a warranty discount on an entire replacement system, and/or provide remedies other than those mentioned in this document.

WARRANTY PROCESS

A Return Authorization number must be obtained from our Customer Service Department prior to returning any product. We may require the original item to be returned postage prepaid for final determination. Shipping charges will apply for any repair or replacement. Other than postage or shipping charges, no charge will be made for repair or replacement under this warranty.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights. As an owner, you may also have additional rights and remedies under the laws of your state.

WARRANTY REGISTRATION

Warranty registration must be on file and/or proof of original purchase (detailed and dated receipt) required for warranty to be effective.
