
PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Beginning on the driver side of the vehicle, remove (2) M10 OEM bolts (or plastic plugs) from each mounting location on the rocker panel if they are present. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. If any OEM mounting plates are present, remove them by removing the M10 bolt using a 15MM socket. See **Figure 2**. Note: Factory rock sliders must be removed in order to install this product.







- 4. Loosely install (1) Driver Mounting Bracket "A" (Item 3) to the rocker panel using the supplied M10 hardware as shown in **Figure 3.** Please refer to **Figures 5 and 6** for bracket orientation and locations.
- 5. Loosely install (2) Driver Mounting Bracket "B" (Item 5) to the rocker panel using the supplied M10 hardware as shown in **Figure 4.** Please refer to **Figures 5 and 6** for bracket orientation and locations.
- 6. Repeat **Steps 2-5** on the passenger side of the vehicle.







- 7. Use the supplied serrated M10 Hardware (Items 10 and 11) to attach the Outlaw Running Boards (Items 1 and 2) to the Mounting Brackets. See **Figure 7**.
- 8. Align and adjust the Outlaw Running Boards as needed. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M10 to 38 ft-lbs.


