









PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.



- 2. Locate the front mounting holes on the driver side of the vehicle and remove the factory bolts.
- 3. Loosely install Driver Bracket A (item 3) using the M8 hardware (items 7-9). See Figure 1.




- 4. Remove the factory hardware from the center and rear mounting holes.
- 5. Loosely install (1) Driver Bracket B (item 5) in the center mounting location using the M8 hardware (items 7-9). See Figure 2.
- 6. Loosely install (1) Driver Bracket B (item 5) in the rear mounting location using the M8 hardware (items 7-9).

- 7. Repeat Steps 2-6 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- 8. Using the M10 hardware (items 10 and 11), loosely attach the Step Bar Assemblies (items 1 and 2) to the brackets. See Figure 3
- 9. Align and adjust the running boards and brackets as needed. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs, M10 hardware to 35-38 ft-lbs.




