PROCEDURE


Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.



- 2. Starting with the driver side front bracket, locate the holes where the bracket will installed. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Attach a Large Bracket Cover (item 10) to the Front Driver Bracket (item 3) using the M6 hardware (items 15-17). See Figure 2.
- 4. Loosely install the bracket using the M10 hardware (items 12-14). See Figure 3.







- 5. Locate the holes where the middle bracket will be installed. See Figure 4.
- 6. Attach a Small Bracket Cover (item 9) to the Middle Driver Bracket (item 5) using the M6 hardware (items 15-17). See Figure 5.
- 7. Loosely install the bracket using the M10 hardware (items 12-14). See Figure 6.





- 8. Locate the holes where the rear bracket will be installed. See **Figure 7**.
- 9. Attach a Large Bracket Cover (item 10) to the Rear Driver Bracket (item 7) using the M6 hardware (items 15-17).
- 10. Loosely install the bracket using the M10 hardware (items 12-14). See Figure 8.
- 11. Repeat steps 2-7 on the passenger side of the vehicle.






- 12. Insert the plate adapters (**item 11**) into the board assemblies by first putting them in parallel to the board, then turning them 90 degrees to be perpendicular to the board. (Make sure the plate hooks onto the bottom of the bracket, and the screws are facing outwards. See **Figure 9**.
 - *Note:* Put 2 adapter plates in the front side and 1 in the back.
- 13. Install the running board onto the previously installed brackets using the supplied M8 hardware. See Figure 10.
 - *Note:* Make sure the plate adapters align with the brackets to attach the board to the mounting brackets.)
- 14. Align step bar and brackets to desired positioning then torque and tighten all: M10 hardware to 38 ft-lbs, M8 hardware to 20ft-lbs and M6 hardware to 7.4 ft-lbs.






