


#### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
  - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Open the hood of the vehicle and remove the plastic cover at the front using a pry tool. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove the four bolts holding the grille in place. See **Figure 2**.
- 4. Remove 2 bolts attaching wheel well cover to filler panel. See **Figures 3 & 4** for reference.









- 5. Pry off fenders to access the filler panel clips. See Figure 4.
- 6. Carefully pry off the filler panel by pulling and removing any clips holding it in place. See **Figure 5** for reference.
- 7. Disconnect any electrical plugs and remove any bolts still attaching the grill to the vehicle. See Figure 6.
- 8. Pry off any remaining clips that are attaching the grill to the vehicle and carefully remove the grille.










- 9. Remove four upper bumper bolts attaching the bumper to the frame and remove the two bottom bolts attaching bumper arm to the frame. See **Figure 7 & 8** for reference.
- 10. Remove the vehicle bumper. *Note:* Assistance may be needed.




- 11. Once the OEM bumper is removed, remove the parking sensors, sensor wiring harness, and the OEM fog lights. Remove the sensors carefully and make sure to pay attention to the sensor orientation since they must be reinstalled in that orientation. See **Figure 9 & 10**.
- 12. If Aerodynamic Active Shutters **are equipped**, remove OE bumper brackets and Shutters carefully as they are fragile. See **Figure 11** for reference.










- 13. Remove the factory tow hooks. See Figure 11 for reference.
- 14. Locate and install the Winch Tray Mounting Brackets loosely (5-6) with the provided M12 hardware (19-23). See **Figures** 12 & 13 for reference. Repeat for passenger side.







- 15. If the OEM Aerodynamic Active Shutters <u>are not</u> equipped, skip to Step 16. <u>If equipped</u>, locate them and the Shutter Relocator Brackets (7-8) and install the shutters to the brackets with the provided M6 hardware (24-27). See **Figure 14 & 15** for reference. Adjust as needed.
- 16. Locate the Winch Tray (2) and install the Winch Tray onto the Winch Tray Brackets using the provided M12 hardware (19 -23). See **Figures 16 and 17** for reference. *Note: If you are installing a winch, do so now.*
- 17. Install all of the bumper accessories prior to installing the bumper onto the vehicle. See **Figure 18 & 19** for reference on installing the LED Center Brackets (14-15).
- 18. Reinstall the Parking Sensors (previously removed in step 11) in the same orientation that they were removed using the OEM parking sensor retainers. See **Figure 20 and 21** for reference. *Note: If parking sensors are not equipped you can use the Center and Outer mesh covers for the openings in the bumper.*

























- 19. Using the OEM hardware, install the Mounting Brackets (3-4) onto the vehicle. See **Figure 22** for reference.
- 20. With help of a second person, install the Pro-Series Bumper onto the Mounting Brackets using the provided M12 hardware (19-22). See **Figure 23-24** for reference.


- Route the parking sensor harness carefully and secure it with zip ties.
- The HYPERQ LED Auxiliary Lights are sold separately. To install, use the provided hardware in the light kit.
