







PROCEDURE


- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting on either side of the vehicles, locate the factory holes on the rocker panel and remove the tape. If your vehicle has threaded holes as shown in **Figure 1**, do not use the provided M8 Riv-Certs (Item 7).
- 3. If threaded holes are not present, use (1) M8 Riv-Certs (Item 7) and insert one into the either hex hole and use the corresponding mounting bracket and provided M8 hardware to "set" the Riv-Cert in place. Insert the M10 Bolt / M8 Nut Plate (Item 6) as shown. See **Figure 2**. <u>Note</u>: See **Figure 3** for instructions on how to properly install the M8 Riv-Cert using the mounting bracket. Also, the Bolt/Nut plate is not used on the driver front mounting location.







If factory threaded holes are present, do not align the nut on the bolt/nut plate. The threaded hole will be used instead of the nut.

4. Proceed to install the Driver Front Mounting Bracket (Item 3) onto the rocker panel by using (2) M8 hex cap screws, (2) M8 lock washers, (2) M8 flat washers (Items 11-13). For the pinch weld, mount the bracket by using the provided M6 hardware (Items 14-16). *Note:* Drilling of two 1/4" holes might be necessary on pinch weld if factory holes are not present. Before drilling, place masking tape on drill surface to prevent any paint damage. See **Figure 4** for reference.







- 5. Loosely mount Driver Center and Rear Mounting Bracket (Item 4) to the rocker panel in the center and rear mounting locations using (2) M8 Hex Bolts, (2) M8 Lock Washers, (2) M8 Flat Washers, (1) M10 Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer, and (1) M10 Hex Nut (Items 8-13). Leave everything loosely in place at this time. See **Figure 5**. <u>Note</u>: The Riv-Cert (Item 7), will only be used when threaded holes are not present. Also, see **Figures 6 & 7** for the proper bracket orientation for both the driver and passenger side.
- 6. Repeat **Step 5** for the Passenger Side Mounting brackets. *See Figures 6 & 7 for the proper bracket orientation for both the driver and passenger side.*



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- 7. For the Outlaw Step Board installation, use the supplied M10 hardware to secure the step bar assembly to the previously installed mounting brackets. See **Figure 8**.
- 8. Align and adjust the step bars and mounting brackets as necessary. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M8 to 15-18 ft-lbs, M10 to 35-38 ft-lbs.





Care Instructions

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
