Toyota A90 Supra - Flywheel Bolt Installation

Use of a thread locking compound or sealant when installing flywheel bolts is mandatory. The crankshaft threads are open to the timing chain cavity, and failure to properly seal these threads may result in oil seepage or leakage at the crankshaft area.

All flywheel bolt installations must include one of the following:

- Bolts with a pre-applied thread locking compound.
- Application of a high-temperature thread locker or suitable thread sealant (e.g., Loctite 272 or equivalent) during installation.

Note: Failure to follow this procedure may result in oil leakage and is not considered an installation defect of the component itself.

Installation Notes:

- Ensure threads are clean and free of oil prior to applying thread locker or sealant.
- Apply compound evenly along the bolt threads.
- Torque bolts to the manufacturer's specified torque values.



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
